## **EIGE/2015/OPER/12. Questions & Answers Nr 2**

### **Question 2:**

The Terms of Reference mention in section 1.3 that 'the contract mainly focuses on, but not limited to, intimate partner violence, femicide, and rape'. Similarly, in section 1.2.5, it mentions that 'the study should also analyse other forms of violence against women (for example, female genital mutilation) and develop recommendations on the definition for statistical purposes and the coding of these forms of violence'. The description of the activities, in particular the data collection and analysis, and deliverables appears to focus on rape, femicide and intimate partner violence. Could you clarify which activity and deliverable other than activity 4.2 (for FGM) should also cover other forms of violence against women?

### **Answer 2:**

The study on Terminology and indicators for data collection on rape, femicide and intimate partner violence will focus on rape, femicide, and intimate partner violence, and where possible, EIGE envisions that the contractor will also include female genital mutilation as a fourth form of gender-based violence to focus on. However, where this is not possible, the contractor should restrict focus to the three abovementioned forms of violence.
